Dijon, capital of Burgundy.

The Palais des Ducs et des Etats de Bourgogne (ducal palace), Notre-Dame Church, Burgundy snails, Dijon mustard, getting about on a Segway electric scooter, shopping for regional produce.

Reims in the Champagne region, City of Art and History

Its unrivalled Unesco World Heritage Sites: Notre-Dame Cathedral, Palais du Tau, Saint-Remi basilica and abbey-museum, the great Champagne houses, the vineyards, the Reims countryside.



1 Abbaye de Cluny

Priceless remains of the most important abbey of the Middle Ages. The parts of the abbey that still stand give an idea of the size and splendour of this building. A 3D virtual film takes you on a tour of the abbey church in its heyday in the 13th century.

2 Château de Condé: the jewel is inside!

A listed building inhabited all year round, this residence of princes and former governors of Champagne will enchant you. Built at the foot of the vineyards, its interior was designed by the most eminent artists of the Enlightenment (Watteau, Boucher, Oudry...). A tour filled with authentic surprises.

3 Château Fort de Sedan

The largest fortress in Europe. With an area of 35000 m², the Château Fort de Sedan, now a listed historic building, recounts its history in the Historium, a tour with scenes from the lives of people and soldiers in the Middle Ages reconstructed in minute detail.

4 Abbaye de Fontenay

A masterpiece of Romanesque art and a Unesco World Heritage

Site! At the bottom of a small valley designated as a conservation area, Fontenay Abbey has remained miraculously intact for more than eight centuries. The monks were expelled during the French revolution, but the old buildings still conjure up the life of the monks of the Cistercian order who founded over 1000 abbeys in Europe in the Middle Ages!

5 Guédelon - a medieval building site

At Guédelon, a medieval building site, they are building a fortress! 15 km from Saint-Fargeau in Burgundy, in the middle of a forest, 35 builders are constructing a fortress as they would have done in the Middle Ages using 13th-century techniques. This fantastic construction project, which will take 25 years, offers a fabulous journey through time.

6 Route historique des Ducs de Bourgogne

17 of the finest tourist attractions in Burgundy - famous for more than 500 years for its extraordinarily rich historical, architectural and gastronomic heritage, and for the beauty of its landscapes.

→ Its protected historic centre, one of the biggest in France (97 hectares), and its "Owl Trail" a walking tour with guides in several languages including English and Chinese. The vineyards of Burgundy, 35 Côte de Nuits AOCs including the famous Romanée Conti. Fontenay Abbey, a Unesco World Heritage Site.
